ARRT Pass Rate

What does this mean?

In 2010, 3 of 3 students who completed the program and graduated, passed the National Registry on their first attempt. The five-year average includes classes from 2006 to 2010, which includes 35 students.

Average ARRT Scores

What does this mean?

The ARRT exam is broken down into 5 subsections. The class of 2010's total score averaged 88 percent, and the five-year average score is 83 percent.

The lowest passing score for the registry is 75 percent.

What does this mean?

The entire class of 2010 was employed in the field of Radiology upon completion of the program. The five-year average indicates that 100 percent of our total graduates were employed in the field of Radiology.

Graduation Rate

What does this mean?

Each year the program accepts a certain number of students, based on the Radiology job market (not to exceed eleven students). The class of 2010 started with 6 students and of that 3 completed the program successfully. The five-year average is based on 35 students.
